The *Wall of Fame* was created to recognize Wyandotte High School basketball players who continued their careers by competing at the NCAA Division I level and/or professionally.

The **Wyandotte High School Hall of Fame**, however, has a much broader purpose. It is intended to honor Bulldog alumni, educators, coaches, and supporters whose achievements, leadership, service, and contributions have brought distinction to Wyandotte High School in a wide variety of fields. This includes, but is not limited to, athletics, education, business, military service, public service, the arts, community leadership, and other areas of excellence.

While the 20 & Counting Project is providing the leadership and organizational support to help revitalize the Hall of Fame process, the Hall of Fame will remain a distinct and independent recognition dedicated to celebrating the many accomplishments of the entire Bulldog family.
